APRIL

This is an overnight weekend tour with four ½ day tours: 1) La Sal Mountain Loop to Castleton and Red Cliff Lodge back to Moab, 2) Arches National Park with a hike or two (Delicate Arch and/or Landscape Arch) and back to Moab, 3) Dead Horse Point/Canyonlands National Park back to Moab, 4) Red Cliffs of the Colorado River and back to SLC. Each ½ day tour segment will begin in Moab for breakfast (restaurant YTBD) and return to Moab except for the final tour which will return to SLC. Noted Chef and Moab local Ken Moody will host the Friday night cookout again and has some special plans throughout the weekend for us. We should be back in SLC on Monday before 6pm.
